Subject: 'The Amazing Lord Jesus'
Matthew 5-7

- 1. **Jesus' authority as Teacher:** the Scribes spoke 'by authority' while Jesus spoke 'with authority. He assumed the right to teach absolute truth.
- 2. Jesus' authority as the Christ: He inaugurated God's kingdom, He admitted people into it and bestowed blessings on them.
- 3. Jesus' authority as the Lord: He did not complain that people called Him Lord, He accepted it as appropriate.
- Jesus' authority as the Saviour: He not only taught salvation, He bestowed it.
- Jesus' authority as Judge: the accused will address their case to Him, and He will be the one to answer them.
- **6. Jesus' authority as God:** Jesus regarded obeying Him as Lord and doing the Father's will as equivalents, thus putting Himself on a level with God.
